## Requirements for the application of foreign students to the PhD-program

If you are looking for a doctorate at the Johannes Gutenberg University of Mainz, please apply <u>online</u> for the acceptance as a PhD student

The following documents need to be submitted to the Dean's Office at Faculty 08:

- two translated copies\* of your final degrees (Bachelor, Master, Diploma etc.)
- two translated copies\* of your school leaving certificate
- two copies of your curriculum vitae, including an outline of your course of studies at high school and university,
- one compilation (transcript of records) of lectures, courses and seminars,
- one detailed list of experimental work done in advanced lab courses,
- one copy of your master thesis and, if written in a language other than German or English, a short summary of your thesis in English,
- one statement by the prospective supervisor at Mainz on your scientific qualifications and an evaluation of your thesis to determine if it is comparable to a **good** German diploma or master thesis,
- two copies of a Proof of adequate knowledge of the German or English language, enrollment regulations § 7
- two copies of the Certificate of recognition, issued by International Office Incoming
- two copies of your passport
